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FLEA TREATMENT PREPARATION

Before Treatment:

- Remove all child and pet toys from the floors.
- Thoroughly vacuum carpets, rugs and upholstered furniture.
- Aquarium and fishbowl air pumps should be turned off and the aquarium/fishbowl covered with a towel or blanket.
- Remove pet food dishes from the floor.
- Furniture should be moved 3 inches from the walls in order to treat the inner perimeter.
- All persons and pets should vacate the premises during treatment and not reenter for a minimum of 4 (four) hours.
- It is recommended that all fur-bearing pets (cats & dogs, etc.) be treated for fleas prior to reentry to the house.

After Treatment:

- Thoroughly vacuum carpets, rugs and upholstery to remove dead and dying fleas. Remove vacuum bag, place vacuum bag into a plastic bag, tie it shut and dispose of it outside. An alternative measure would be to place a cat flea collar inside the vacuum cleaner bag. This will eliminate the need to dispose of the bag so often.
- Continue flea treatment of pets.
- Schedule your next inside flea treatment. Treatments are good for up to one year. It is recommended to have a treatment no less than twice a year to keep up the effectiveness.
- CONTINUE TO VACUUM CARPETS FOR TWO WEEKS MINIMUM FOR BEST RESULTS.
